

June 3rd 1975.

Minutes of meeting held at 8 p.m., attended by approx
20 of the general public.

The Chairman, W. Gordon Williams, presided and gave a brief account of the Community Council's activities during the first year of its existence and paid tribute to its members for their support and regular attendance at meetings. He invited comments or questions from those present and the two main items raised, which called for action were as follows:

1. Excessive speed of cars along Crafnant road, particularly from Gwmanog to the main road in the village. It was asked if a speed limit of 20 m.p.h. could be instituted.
2. The danger to children from the dilapidated condition of the two huts at the Recreation Ground.
3. The need of attention to a footpath raised by Mrs

The Chairman gave an undertaking that these would be attended to and then proceeded with the main business of the evening namely transfer of assets to the Borough Council. Dealing first with the Hall, he outlined the financial advantage in the event of a transfer as the Borough Council would be responsible for rates and for the structural maintenance of the fabric whilst the day to day management of the Hall would still rest with the Management Committee. The same applied to the Children's Playing Field where the annual maintenance costs are heavy against small revenue, but the Recreation Ground was in a different category as it is partly maintained by Gwynedd Education Cee

After a full discussion, for & against, the matter was put to a vote and by an overwhelming majority it was decided to transfer ownership of the Hall to the Borough Council. On a majority vote it was also decided to transfer the Playing Field but that we retain possession of the Recreation Ground.
