

Potential installation of a Defib unit at Llyn Geirionydd

A concern has been raised that the sheer number of visitors to Llyn Geirionydd poses an increased risk of someone suffering heart problems in a remote rural area where emergency assistance could be too late to save a life.

Such an installation would have to rely on the following:

- NRW / SNP being agreeable to the installation at the toilet block and use of their electricity (a very small cost to ensure the unit doesn't freeze in the winter)
- Tomos from Welsh Ambulance making enquiries with various sources to contribute to and cover the cost of the defib unit and the cabinet
- TCC covering the cost of installation max £265
- The defib being an unlocked unit as there is no phone signal to call 999 for the code to open the door
