Meet Your Councillor Surgeries 2023

Introduction and background

In 2022, Trefriw Community Council (TCC) trialed the introduction of Meet Your Councillor surgeries. These were run every other month in between Council meetings, and were advertised on posters/flyers around the village and on social media. Each surgery was run by two community councillors, with our County Councillor also attending where possible. Ward residents were invited to use the surgeries as an informal way of raising ad hoc issues outside of the regular Council meetings.

Proposal for 2023

Public attendance at the surgeries throughout 2022 was limited with no more than four people coming to any one session. Therefore, it is proposed that the surgeries are offered on a quarterly basis to limit the draw on Cllrs' time whilst still offering this informal contact route for residents. The draft timetable is below; Cllrs are asked to volunteer to co-host one surgery each during 2023. The dates and times should be agreed between the relevant hosts in time for the whole schedule to be approved at the full Council meeting on 10 January 2023. The Clerk will then publicise this.

It is the responsibility of individual councillors to find a swap if they are unable to co-host their planned surgery due to unforeseen circumstances.
