Welcome to our Newsletter!

We are trialling a newsletter to tell you what we're doing, what's on, and how you can get involved!

What is TCC? We are the community council for Trefriw and Llanrhychwyn (previously known as a parish council). Our purpose is to help make Trefriw and Llanrhychwyn ('our wards') a nice place to live and visit.

Who is TCC? All Community Councillors are volunteers who live in our wards. Most of us also work and have busy family lives! Our full complement is nine councillors – seven represent the Trefriw ward and two represent the Llanrhychwyn ward. Councillors' names and contact details are on the next page; they are also listed on the village notice boards by Trefriw hall and in Llanrhychwyn and on our website: www.trefriwcommunitycouncil.co.uk. We also employ one part time Clerk.

What does TCC do? We are the first port of call for residents about problems in the community! We will try to help where we can, which may include referring you to other bodies, e.g. Conwy County Borough Council (CCBC), Snowdonia National Park Authority (SNPA) or Natural Resources Wales (NRW).

Our meeting minutes tell you what we're doing - they are posted on the village notice boards and on our website. Things we are responsible for in Trefriw and Llanrhychwyn are: reviewing planning applications; providing community skips; maintaining the cemetery and liaising with funeral directors and families to arrange burials and memorials; maintaining village benches, planters and the war memorial; looking after our recreation ground and playparks; maintaining and hiring the village hall; and supplying the village Christmas tree and lights!
